





Dakota. The Foundation is led by a CEO, Whitney A. Rencountre II, Crow Creek Hunkpati Dakota, who stated, "We are excited to celebrate the 75th Anniversary of Crazy Horse Memorial. We would like to honor the work of all those who have contributed to Crazy Horse Memorial: past, present, and into the fu-

ture." Crazy Horse Memorial has progressed through many changes since the June 3, 1948 dedication of the one-of-akind educational and humanitarian project. What began as a dream, turned into a friendship sealed with promise, and continues to unfold as a story unlike any other. Transitioning from the time of Chief Henry Standing Bear communicating the importance of the project, to sculptor Korczak Ziolkowski and his wife Ruth's unwavering commitment to

vancing the foundation's mission, to a new era of the project which is now carried on by a dedicated Board of Directors, members of the Ziolkowski family, Management, and Staff.

There are many significant things taking place as the Dream carries on:

Since 2010, over 350 students have walked through the doors of The Indian University of North America®, representing over 40 Native Nations and more than 20 states through the 7th GEN.® and Wizipan Programs.

The Museum continues to collect and care for thousands of artifacts on display for numerous visitors to see. Additionally, Native performances through The Indian Museum of North America®, showcasing unique glimpses into cultures from diverse ecoregions, are now offered year round with opportunities daily through the peak season.

Current carving work is leading to breathtaking changes on Crazy Horse's Hand and Arm. All of the fingers on Crazy Horse's Hand are now clearly discernable as is much of his Arm. Portions of the Horse's Mane


are also taking shape. Since 1998, when the face was finished, a lot of time and effort was spent removing bulk rock. Because of this, the Crew is now within 20 feet (or less) of finished grade on much of the Mountain. Thus, the exciting finish work happening now will likely continue for years into the future, bringing






